

DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY (PPWR)

Statement of Compliance with Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation)

1. Scope and Product Description

This Statement of Compliance relates to all corrugated packaging manufactured and supplied by Labro Verpakkingen B.V., categorized into the following categories:

- **Corrugated packaging** (whether glued or not)
- **Laminated corrugated packaging** (provided with a 170-gram MC paper print sheet, whether glued or not)

Our packaging is composed of raw materials and auxiliary materials (corrugated sheets, water-based dispersion adhesives, hotmelts, and printing inks) originating from certified European suppliers.

The corresponding supplier declarations, safety data sheets (SDS), and technical data sheets (TDS) are secured in our quality management system and will be made available by Labro Verpakkingen B.V. upon request to competent authorities or customers.

2. Statement of Compliance Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR)

Labro Verpakkingen B.V. declares that all supplied packaging complies with the applicable requirements of **Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR)**, which enters into force on **12 August 2026**.

Compliance has been established based on the specifications and guarantees per statutory article:

Article 5 - Requirements for substances in packaging

Heavy metals (Art. 5.4):

The sum of concentrations of lead (Pb), cadmium (Cd), mercury (Hg), and hexavalent chromium (Cr VI) in the packaging and components thereof remains well below the statutory limit of **100 mg/kg (100 ppm)**.

Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances / PFAS (Art. 5.5)

No PFAS substances are intentionally added during the manufacture of our packaging and the production of purchased basic raw materials.

- The total fluorine content (Total Fluorine screening) in the corrugated board is below the reference value of 50 ppm.
- All processed adhesives and printing inks demonstrably comply with the standards regarding the absence of intentionally added PFAS.

Article 6 - Recyclability of packaging

Our corrugated packaging is designed to be recyclable within existing paper recycling streams. The basic corrugated board has been proven recyclable at scale.

The cold glues and hotmelts used are designed and used in such appropriate quantities that they do not adversely affect the recyclability of the cardboard or disrupt standard pulping processes.

Future clause: We expect that our paper-based products will be fully compliant with the delegated acts for "Design for Recycling", which are expected to enter into force before 2028.

Article 10 - Packaging minimization

Our packaging is designed according to customer specifications and industry standards used (such as the FEFCO catalogue) to limit weight and volume to what is necessary for the protection, safety, and functionality of the packaged product.

- The assessment methodology for minimization relevant to the PPWR will be definitively established before **01-01-2030**.

Article 12 - Labelling of packaging

The mandatory specifications and pictograms for labelling will be published by the European Commission via an implementing act (Implementing Act, expected before **12 August 2026**). Labro Verpakkingen B.V. will align its labelling and product markings with these guidelines in a timely manner within the applicable transitional periods.

3. Additional Regulations: REACH & Safety

In addition to the PPWR legislation, we declare the following regarding our packaging and raw materials:

REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006:

All suppliers of Labro Verpakkingen B.V. confirm full compliance with the REACH Regulation. The packaging contains no Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) from the REACH Candidate List in a concentration exceeding 0.1% (w/w).

4. Final Provision and Substantiation

This declaration has been drawn up in response to current legislation and is based on the formal declarations of conformity, technical data sheets (TDS), and safety data sheets (SDS) of our raw material suppliers.

Labro Verpakkingen B.V. continues to actively monitor the further development and publication of delegated acts under the PPWR and will revise this declaration if amended regulations or raw material specifications give cause to do so.
